
Blackberry Hill Development update

Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on Blackberry Hill and what you can expect from us as the development nears completion.

Blackberry Hill in Fishponds, Bristol

The development, which blends beautifully restored Grade II buildings with sympathetically designed modern new builds, provides 380 homes, a memorial garden and includes 100 affordable properties on the former Blackberry Hill Hospital site.

The last homes are being sold from Boardwalk estate agents in Bristol.



Services

The current service providers are:

- Ista (heating and hot water)
- British Gas (electric)
- Bristol Water (water)
- OFNL (broadband)



Managing agent

The managing agent is FirstPort and the management company is Blackberry Hill Management Company Ltd.

The first part of the development has been handed over to the managing agent and you will receive additional communication from them directly regarding the next handover.

Site activity

- Broadband is connected.
- The roads in phase 1 and 1a have been topped and they are awaiting yellow lines (weather dependent). All roads should be topped towards the end of the year.
- The memorial garden has been completed, which has a path running through the middle. A service and memorial plaque is due to be installed in the future.
- Solar streetlights are due to be installed this spring/early summer.
