Overview

Overview of what's being built. In addition, the development will provide:

- 300 homes, 75 of which are affordable
- Attenuation basins
- New sub station
- Photovoltaic panels etc and EV charging
- New pumping station

Site activity

- 75 homes currently in construction
- Moving towards completion of phase 1 mid-August 2024
- Of the homes currently under construction, we are at various stages of build, from foundations to finishes

Muck away update

• We are currently moving some spoil piles off site. This is a Heavy Plant operation which needs to be carried out for planning conditions and should complete first tranche late-May.

Timeline



- Important dates: first completions are anticipated for June 2024*
- Show homes and marketing suite are now open to the public
- The roads and footpaths to the site will be completed in line with the construction site progress
- We are anticipating full site completion in September 2025*

Ecology

- Newt fencing remains in place and will be removed in sections in agreement with ecologists as construction progresses
- Hedgehog highways are being installed throughout the development
