Site Activity



- Last homes are now available at Hubbard's Walk
- 80% of plots are watertight
- Completion of 100% of adopted road completed ready for final top finish
- All site mains drainage is complete
- All mixed tenure homes have completed and handed over to Sage
- Site team have now moved into temporary accommodation to commend works to the last plots



Ecology

- Two parts of the site when fully completed are designed to be Public Open Space and a play area on site.
- The site will also benefit from having a SuDS (Sustainable Drainage System) on the site. SuDS allow for natural drainage patterns to be recreated and they also reduce the volume of surface water runoff reaching drains and other watercourses, this in turn then drastically reduces the risk of any surface water flooding the immediate area.



Managing agent

- Greenbelt have been appointed as the Managing Agent to care for the public open spaces at Ferriby Fields.
- They are responsible for routine maintenance, regular inspections to check up on any previous identified matters and report any concerns, administrative services such as annual reviews as well as expert consultancy in line with Health & Safety legislations.

How will the development benefit the local community?

Hubbard's Walk will also support the local community by contributing over £216,000 towards:

- S106 contributions, local donations
- Over £180,000 education contribution to the local council. This figure will go towards a multitude of different elements such as improving existing infrastructure in the area and creating new educational opportunities.
- £36,000 contributed to the National Health Service (NHS)
- 30% of the units on site are to be fully delivered through the S106 agreement with the local council in line with the areas local plan
