We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Summary of what's being built:

- 75 Open Market homes sold by Linden Homes
- 127 Pre-sold homes
- Local Equipped Area of Play
- Attenuation Pond

Site activity

- To date we have completed 65 homes – a mix of pre-sold and open market.
- We have been working our way up from homes 109-100 and in the rear of these homes 110-123 bringing them out the ground and up first lift brickwork.
- This spring we are looking to complete the street scene from homes 109 to 104 and then completing homes 64 to 71 to pre-handover stage.

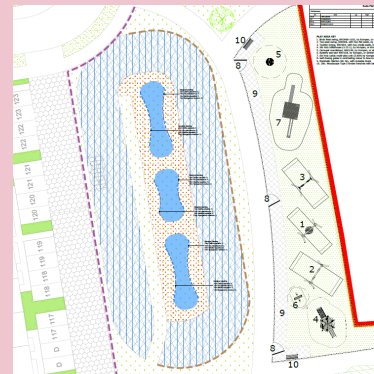
Mains water connections

We are currently chlorinating wate to the top end of the development, ready for future home connections as the build progresses.

Timeline



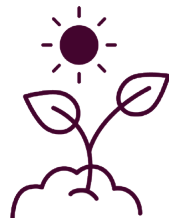
- The first completions at Stamford Gardens took place in April 2023.
- The Show Home & Sales Centre are now open. Please check our website for the most up to date opening times.
- Opening date of play parks and larger area of public open space will be in late 2024. We will provide an update closer to the time.
- All main roads coming through site will have the final surfacing course once the final home is completed.
- Completion on site expected in late 2025.



Ecology

Over the course of the development, we will be planting over 100 new trees and shrubs and ornamental hedge to gardens. The public open space, which includes an attenuation pond will include species-rich grass mix, wetland flower mix, and planting to the edge of the waterline. 4 new trees have just been planted across plots 52 – 64. We are also installing hedgehog highways to fence lines.

Pollinator friendly seed packets are being provided for every new homeowner to sow in
