We wanted to provide you with an update so you're aware of the final stages of construction, and as we hand the development over to the managing agent and the roads are adopted.

#### Overview

The development will include:

- 175 new homes, 52 of which are affordable
- LEAPs (Local Area Equipment for Play),
   NEAPs (Neighbourhood Equipped Area of Play, MUGAs (Multi-Use Games Areas)
- Attenuation basin
- EV charging

#### Site activity

- Legal completion of plot 50
- Upcoming legal completions of plots 94/101
- New service connections to plots 103-108
- Joist & trusses to plots 124-132
- 1st/2nd fixing to plots 105-112

## **Timeline**

- Important dates: first completions June 2021. Most recent completion 5<sup>th</sup> April
- Show home and marketing suite opening date August 2020
- Opening date of play parks and larger areas Summer 2024
- Roads and footpaths in place outside of the site boundary

- Hedgehog highways being installed as site progresses




## Managing agent
