We wanted to provide you with an update so you're aware of the final stages of construction, and as we hand the development over to the managing agent and the roads are adopted.

Overview

The development will include:

- 175 new homes, 52 of which are affordable in line with Section 106 agreement
- LEAPs (Local Area Equipment for Play),
 NEAPs (Neighbourhood Equipped Area of Play, MUGAs (Multi-Use Games Areas)
- Attenuation basin

Site activity

- Final stairs going in for plot 140/141
- Joist & trusses complete on site
- 1st/2nd fixing to plots 130-141

Specific item -

All services and drains are complete on site.

Timeline

- Important dates: first completions June 2021.
- Show home and marketing suite opening date August 2020
- Opening date of play parks and larger areas Mid-late 2024
- Roads and footpaths in place outside of the site boundary
- Site exit date anticipated end of 2024



Ecology

- Bat and bird boxing being installed as site progresses
- Hedgehog highways being installed as site progresses



Managing agent

- Managing agent at Avisford Grange is Gateway Property Management .
- Handover of the first section of development anticipated in Summer 2024

- GTC for gas, electric & fibre
- Portsmouth Water
